CODE OF CONDUCT

LAZER BLAST Players Must Follow The Laser Tag Code of Conduct
(The code is for your safety and enjoyment)

- 1 Laser Tag is a Non-Contact Sporting Game**
This means no physical contact between you and other players. To avoid players accidentally falling down or colliding with other players, excessive running is strictly forbidden.
- 2 Sensors must be visible**
Do not use anything to cover up the Sensors thereby preventing you from receiving hits. If you want to avoid being tagged, you must take cover behind something.
- 3 Lazer Blast Game Arena**
Players must remain inside the gaming area at all times.
- 4 The Lazer Blast Referees are in-charge**
No arguments, the referees instructions are final.
- 5 Laser Tag Sportsmen are Honourable**
Lack of sportsmanship (disrespect for people & property, bad language) will not be tolerated. Laser Tag sportsmen never lie, cheat or take advantage of a fallen foe. Players must remember that Laser Tag is only a game.
- 6 Laser Tag is a Team Game**
Depending on the type of mission, Laser Tag can be individually competitive, however, in many of the games you must consider the success of the team first.
